## PROGRAM PROCESS

### 1. Submit Application

*After submission of online application at  
[www.wiseup.work/wise-u](http://www.wiseup.work/wise-u)*

*WISE U will contact applicant within 10 business days via email*

### 2. Orientation & Interview

*Applicant will participate in a mandatory WISE U Orientation then attend a scheduled Readiness Interview*

**Background checks required for in-person cohorts\***

### 3. Peer Training Academy

*11 days of in-class instruction or 16 days virtual instruction.  
Curriculum based on the Peer Support Core Competencies as outlined by SAMHSA*

### 4. Fieldwork Experience

*20 hours of supervised fieldwork pertaining to peer support services. Each participant will receive a certificate upon completion of the full course*

### 5. Career Mentoring & Placement Assistance

*WISE U Participants receive placement assistance and job support for 6 months after completion of in-class training*
